There are two versions of the International Career Market: The **internet** and the **intranet** version. DB Schenker supplies you an easy way to copy the plug-in in the ECM:

- The **internet** version
 - Shows only external job vacancies

- The **intranet** version
 - Shows internal and external job vacancies

Note: Just copy the respective template from the „shared_global“ folder into your local folder. It is a „Content module HTML fragement“ that can be placed e.g. in the content of a page.

Locations of the copy templates:

- The **internet** version - „**careerMarket_html_INTERNet**“

ECM folder path:

/../shared_global/language_independent/copy_template_careermarket/careerMarket_html_INTERNet

- The **intranet** version - „**careerMarket_html_INTRANet**“


ECM folder path:

Parameter: Country code

Note: In your local copy of the respective „Content module HTML fragment“ you can adjust the prepared configurable parameters in the „Parameters“ field of the module.

Just set the required Alpha-2 code as value for the parameter „content_countrycode“. The selected country will appear on top of the list.
