Market Updates:

There is no significant update since the last advisory.

In general, Air Freight is encountering serious capacity issues on all trade lanes due to massive cancellation of passenger flights. Extensive implementation of blank sailings is also largely impacting rates and capacities of Ocean Freight. There is no major issue to Contract Logistics and Land Transport.

We will continue to monitor all stakeholders of respective modes.

This is the last regular update since recent changes have been marginal. We will provide an update as soon as major change occurs in the future.
